Visiting bands for ACB conferences are selected by a blind audition process. Each band submits recordings of recent concerts and are evaluated by a team of directors and ACB representatives. The top selected bands are then offered an invitation to perform at the conference. With Orlando's theme being 'Diversify Our Bands', two of the selected bands along with the host band, Central Florida Sounds of Freedom had something in common. All three bands are members of the Pride Bands Alliance (www.pridebands. org) formerly known as the Lesbian and Gay Band Association. Pride Bands Alliance holds their own conferences once a year, and are hosted by member bands, much like ACB. These three Florida Bands (CFSOF, Tampa Pride Band and South Florida Pride Wind Ensemble) decided to join together to perform three works from LGBTQ+ identifying composers. They have also invited members of any Pride Bands Alliance band who will be attending the ACB conference to join them in this performance. This 'Massed Pride Band' performance will be the opening act for the Convention Band on Saturday night, May 20th.

The Massed Pride Band will perform three very important works: "One Life Beautiful" by Julie Giroux, and two pieces commissioned

by Pride Bands Alliance members to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Stonewall Riots, Omar Thomas' "A Mother of A Revolution!," and Randall Standridge's "Stonewall: 1969."

Panel Discussions and More!

ACB Convention Band rehearsals with the three Guest Conductors will take place on Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings. In the afternoons, there will be panel discussions with these conductors as well as other notable composers and conductors in attendance. These will be moderated panel discussions with Q&A. This will be a great opportunity to learn!

Conductor masterclasses will be available from Composer-In Residence, Giovanni Santos. Dr. Santos has proudly implemented

a yearly wind band conducting workshop at La Sierra University where he serves as Director of Wind and Percussion Studies. This workshop will take place on Friday afternoon. Convention registrants may sign-up to participate in the workshop. The nine masterclass slots will be available on first-come-first-served basis.

There will be two Music Reading Sessions. This will be an opportunity to hear music from new composers and diverse composers. The Music Reading Sessions will include music from grade 1-5 to give a variety of new music from living and a diverse sampling of composers. Volunteers from

the ACB Convention Band will be used as the reading band for these sessions. Convention attendees may sign-up to participate in the reading band on one or both days.
